**ORDER REGARDING APPLICATION
TO PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS
AND COMMUNICATION WITH THE
COURT**

Plaintiff Rev. Ryan Sasha Gallagher, proceeding pro se, filed this civil action alleging that Defendants Bitcointalk.org, Martti Malmi, and the Bitcoin Foundation are engaging in an illegal monopoly. (Dkt. No. 1.) Plaintiff’s complaint was accompanied by an application to proceed in forma pauperis; however, the application is incomplete. (Dkt. No. 2.) Plaintiff has drawn lines through portions of the application, including his monthly expenses, and in response to the question regarding whether he has received any money within the last 12 months he has indicated that he receives federal and state welfare payments of \$200 per month and that “bitcoin is not money.” (*Id.* at 2-3.) Plaintiff shall file an amended application to proceed in forma pauperis and provide a complete accounting of his income and expenses by October 30, 2018. Failure to do so may result in the denial of his application to proceed in forma pauperis.

In addition, Plaintiff has sent numerous emails to the Court’s proposed order email address, which are attached. Plaintiff is advised that all communications with the Court must be filed on the docket.
